

Departing Location Protocols

- A. PIC: Inform ATC of Completion of Flight Plan if Necessary
- B. Final Measure Weather and Check and Mark Pilot's and Operation's Log.
 - Wind Direction
 - Wind Velocity
 - Relative Humidity
 - Barometric Pressure
 - Outside Temperature
 - Flight Duration
 - Flight Performance
- C. Record Flight Notes, and UAS Performance (energy consumed).
- D. Safety Debriefing of Flight and Operations Crews.
- E. Breakdown UAS and Place in Travel Safety Case.
- F. Crew: Carefully Pack Gear and other location Essentials.
 - 1. Gear Checklist in Each Case
 - 2. Make sure each Case has all equipment
 - 3. Refer to each Case Packaging Slip (PDF located in each Case)
- G. Case Checklist
 - 1. Make sure all Cases brought to set are accounted for and Mark on Checklist.
- H. After each Operations all Company Team are require to attend a Safety Debriefing.
- I. Team Meeting to Discuss Flight what was done correctly and what could have been better executed.
- J. Review All Communications and Discuss Improvements, Failures and Edits for the Next Flight Operations.
- K. Review Company Protocols and Discuss Edits, Changes and or Additions to the Various Flight and Operations Protocols.
- L. Discuss with the Team if the Base Camp Diagram and the Tent Location was laid out properly and could it be improved for the Next Project.
